

What Small Businesses Should Know...

- Food and accommodations for emergency workers are required procurements for snow season and are good opportunities for SBR vendors.
- COMAR requires that state agencies check with Community Services
 Providers first for the goods and services listed here:
 http://www.mdworks.com/ew_productsservices.html
- All solicitations over \$15,000 are posted on eMaryland Marketplace Advantage (eMMA).
- We use the direct solicitation method for small procurements under \$15,000; purchases under \$5,000 are typically paid by CPC.
- All IT purchases for our agency are performed by MDOT SHA's Office of Information Technology.
- We strongly encourage all small businesses attend pre-bid meetings.

Small Procurements

(The Small Business Sweet Spot)

<u>Category I</u> (\$0 - \$5,000)

- Hand tools
- Construction vehicle and heavy equipment replacement parts
- Safety shoes
- Portable toilet rental
- Each district makes its own purchases
 by Corporate Purchasing Card (CPC).

<u>Category II</u> (\$5,001 - \$15,000)

- Paving materials
- Minor building maintenance and repair
- Most procurements in this category are for goods bought through Department of General Services statewide contracts.
- Vendors can sign up on eMaryland Marketplace Advantage to bid on current solicitations (https://emma.maryland.com).

<u>Category III</u> (\$15,001 - \$50,000)

- Commodities (not under DGS contract)
- Facilities Maintenance, inc. janitorial, security guard services, landscaping, pest control, elevator maintenance, etc.




